Notes on Road Book.


1. All mileages are from Steve & Gill's and another Land Rover Freelander plus the Brantz 2 Pro Trip meter fitted to their Austin Healey 3000.

2. Expect variations of + or - o.1 miles

- 3. Expect variations for your car, you all probably know how accurate or not, your odometers are on your cars!
- 4. The term 'signed' (name of village/town/place etc) doesn't necessarily mean that you will be going to that place, just head in that direction read all instructions carefully

'Tulip' Instructions and notes.

For those who may not be familiar with 'Tulip' style road book instructions, the main thing to remember is that you start at the black spot (tulip bulb) and leave via the arrow head. See examples below.



Where possible, tulips have been drawn to resemble what you will see in front of you when you reach each way point (WP) road numbers have also been included where possible.

Your entry number is based on the age of your car. The oldest car will leave first, PLEASE be ready to leave about 5 minutes before your booked time.

Cars will be dispatched at 1.5minute intervals from Sheffield Park Station from 9.45am approximately.

You may start the 2nd stage when you like - you are free to stop where you like en-route - view points etc, but please be back at the Hospice by 3.30 - 4.00pm, for the Hog Roast & prize giving.

When you arrive at the end of the Run, please park as directed by the Marshals, who will then direct you to the Day Centre. Please be mindful of the Hospice patients and keep engine noise etc. to a minimum.
